THE EXALTED, DAVIDIC MESSIAH

Main Point: The crucified, risen and ascended Christ is the Davidic Messiah who has ushered in the last days.

Recap: In the person and work of Christ, climactically capped by the outpouring of the Holy Spirit, God has, from heaven, intruded into earthly affairs in a staggering and monumental way in order to bring salvation and judgment, both of which, as currently operative, are precursors to final salvation and judgment at the great Day of the Lord.

THE EXALTED, DAVIDIC MESSIAH

- God's definite plan, man's clear responsibility (vv. 22-23; cf. Acts 4:27-28)
- The Davidic Branch that death could not contain (vv. 24-32)
- Exaltation and the Spirit of Christ (vv. 33)
