

**THE EPISTLE TO THE HEBREWS**  
**6:13-20**

Intro: In our last study of Hebrews, we considered chapter 6:9-12. I have listed the main points of these verses so as to understand the verses we will look at tonight in context.

      - a. Abraham and Israel Vs 14-17
      - b. The NT Believer Vs 18-20
      - c. **Two immutable things, in which it was impossible for God to lie**
        - 1. **Immutable**-cannot be changed
        - 2. **Two immutable things**- His word and His oath by His name cf. Vs 17
        - 3. **In which it was impossible for God to lie**-He placed Himself into such an obligation that He can not remove Himself from His promise
  - B. The \_\_\_\_\_ response of His children Vs 15, 18b-20
    - 1. We \_\_\_\_\_ the God Who has made such promises to His children Vs 18b
      - a. Such action on the part of the believer produces the feeling of great \_\_\_\_\_-**refuge**
      - b. Such action on the part of the believer produces the feeling of great \_\_\_\_\_-**consolation** (confidence)
      - c. Such action on the part of the believer causes the believer to \_\_\_\_\_ to God as his/her only hope for the future- **to lay hold upon the hope set before us**
    - 2. The \_\_\_\_\_ of this type behavior on the part of the believer is: Vs 19
      - a. A confident \_\_\_\_\_ is placed in the heart of that believer by the Holy Spirit Vs 19a
      - b. That hope becomes the \_\_\_\_\_ that keeps the believer secure in the worst of times in our life-**anchor of the soul both sure and steadfast** Vs 19b  
*Cf. Acts 27:20-40*
      - c. That anchor \_\_\_\_\_ the believer into a new relationship of intimacy with the Father like we have never known before-**and which entereth into that within the veil** Vs 19c
        - 1. This type of intimacy can \_\_\_\_\_ be obtained through the "hurricanes and tornados" of life Cf. Vs 15-**Abraham patiently waited for the promise**

2. This type of intimacy can only be understood as one \_\_\_\_\_  
\_\_\_\_\_ to God as the only hope they have for survival in those  
"hurricanes tornados" of life
3. This type of intimacy will produce such \_\_\_\_\_ in the love  
and power of God, the Father for the believer-**Sure and Steadfast**
4. This type of intimacy will \_\_\_\_\_ the life and direction of the  
believer for all eternity-**Which entereth into that within the veil**
  - a. The veil \_\_\_\_\_ the very presence of God from the  
rest of the people
  - b. To go beyond the veil was \_\_\_\_\_ to everyone  
except the High Priest, and he could only enter once each year  
on the Day of Atonement
  - c. Today the "entering into the very presence of God" is made  
available to all believers, but only a \_\_\_\_\_ will accept the  
opportunity
3. This intimate relationship with the Father has been made available to us by \_\_\_\_\_
  - a. Christ \_\_\_\_\_ us into the Holy of Holies with His shed blood-**the  
forerunner**
  - b. Christ entered in our \_\_\_\_\_, not for \_\_\_\_\_-**is for us  
entered**
  - c. Christ entered into the Holy of Holies as the \_\_\_\_\_ High Priest- **made  
an high priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec**

Concl: As Christ suffered the "hurricanes and tornados" of life, His \_\_\_\_\_ was anchored securely in the Father. As a result of His confidence in the Father, He entered a new relationship with Him that He had never known before-the Lamb of God who had given His life a ransom of many. Because of this the Believer is invited to also enter a new found relationship with the Father-an intimacy that is so special and sweet that words cannot adequately explain. This relationship can only be \_\_\_\_\_. Yet those who have entered into this relationship are very well aware of what it is like, and they would not exchange it for anything in this world. This relationship was gained at a high \_\_\_\_\_ by the shedding of Christ's blood, and the suffering of the "hurricanes and tornados" in the believer's life. That is why James said in James 1:2-4 Dear brothers and sisters, when troubles come your way, consider it an opportunity for great joy. 3 For you know that when your faith is tested, your endurance has a chance to grow. 4 So let it grow, for when your endurance is fully developed, you will be perfect and complete, needing nothing. May God help us to understand what He is doing in our personal life so we may enter through the veil into God's inner sanctuary.
