These 17 types are taken from Zuck’s book on Basic Bible Interpretation p 179-180: There are...

1) **Persons:** Melchizedek & Aaron

2) **Events:** a. the 7 feasts of Israel: Passover, Unleavened bread, First Fruits, Pentecost, Trumpets, Day of Atonement, & Tabernacles – all look forward to & find their fulfillment in Christ & b. the Sabbath

3) **Things:** The Tabernacle, the Tabernacle veil/curtain, & the 5 Offerings; Burnt offering, Grain offering, Fellowship offering, Sin offering, & Guilt offering all look forward to their fulfillment in Christ!
