



Pamagat: “And lead us not into temptation,...” [Petition #6]

Bible Text: Matt. 6:13 “And lead us not into temptation,...”

Pagsasalin: At huwag mo kaming dalhin sa tukso,

Panimula:

1. These next two petitions help us in spiritual progress via the Christian’s battle.
2. We are to pray against temptations in the sense of Satan’s invitation to sin.
3. We are to pray for deliverance in Petition #7.
4. We will look at Petition #6.

I. This prayer is not saying that God could lead us into Satanic temptations if we don’t pray this.

- A. James 1:13 – God does not author sin, nor entice us to sin. He is not to be blamed.
- B. This is a prayer to PREPARE us for our Spiritual Battle.
- C. Lead here means “to carry inward” or “to bring” – we are asking God to not permit us to be tempted.
- D. David prayed something similar in Ps. 19:13; and 141:4.
- E. We must take proper preparations against temptations. FIRST by asking for God’s assistance! Every day.

II. We can ask God:

- A. Help us to be sober and vigilant (1 Peter 5:8) – When you pray about this, you are not self-reliant.
- B. Help us to have a Biblically trained conscience (Rom. 2:15)
- C. Help us by your guidance (Ps. 25:5; 143:10)
- D. Help us to find and be involved in church (Ps. 23:2)
- E. Help us to have victory over besetting sins (Heb. 12:1)
- F. Help us to hate sin (Ps. 101:3; 119:128, 163)
- G. Help me to love righteousness (Rom. 12:9)
- H. Help us not to be flattered by this sinful world-system (Ps. 5:9)

Katapusan:

1. Having prayed from cleansing, this following prayer prevents us from entering into it again.
2. We are asking God not to leave us to ourselves.
3. We must pray against temptations.
4. We are in constant danger and trouble because of temptations.
5. This petition is put for the negative, the next will be put for the positive. This is PREPARATION, the next is IMPLIMENTATION.
