- The Pattern for Revival
 - Begins with the Proclamation of God's Word—Nehemiah 8
 - Deepens with the Confession of Sin—Nehemiah 9
 - Solidifies by the Commitments we make—Nehemiah 10

Commitment and Revival?

A. Commitment to Obeying God's Word—Neh. 9:38—10:29

- It was a "binding" agreement—a solemn oath. Num. 30:2; Eccl. 5 It was a "written" agreement It was a "signed" agreement
- - Nehemiah and Zedekiah—civil leaders first
 - 2) Priests—21 individuals or families
 - Levites—17 individuals
 - Heads of Families—44
 - The "rest"—verbal assent to the covenant
- Committed to OBEYING GOD'S WORD

B. Commitment to Distinct Living—Neh. 10:28, 30-31

- Israel was to be distinct from the Gentile nations surrounding them.
- Separation is simply total devotion to God, no matter what the cost.
- Commitment to Distinct Living in two areas:
 - Marriage —10:30 Intermarriage with Gentiles. Exodus 34:12, 5-16; 2 Corinthians 6:14
 - **Business dealings**—10:31 Sabbath Observance b.
 - Exodus 35:1-2; Lev. 25:2-5
- We are to be distinct from world —1 Peter 2:9, 11-12; Phil 2:14-16

Commitment to Support God's Work—Neh. 10:32-39

- Four Ways in which the Jews financially supported the temple
 - Temple Tax—10:32-33 cp. Exod. 30:11-16
 - Wood Offering—10:34 cp. Lev. 6:12-13 b.
 - First Fruits—10:35-37a cp. Prov. 3:9
 - Tithe—10:37b-39 cp. Lev. 20:30-34; Num. 18:25; Deut. 26
- Giving for the support of the temple became a spiritual "thermometer". cp. 2 Chron. 31:9
- "Grace" Giving Today?
 - Give proportionately to our income—1 Cor. 16:1-3
 - Give purposefully, generously, and cheerfully—2 Cor. 9:6-7 b.
 - God's promise of abounding grace as we give—2 Cor. 9:8
