"O How Love I Thy Law!" The First Commandment "Flee From Idolatry!" Exodus 20:3

- 1. Please Turn Back With Me:
 - In Your Bibles To The First:
 - Of The Ten Commandments:
 - That We Find In Exodus 20!
 - Where We Read:
 - In 20:1-3 "And God spake all these words, saying, / I am the LORD thy God, which have brought thee out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage. / *Thou shalt have no other gods before me!*"
- 2. Last Sunday Night:
 - We Started Looking At:
 - The *Doctrine* We Find:
 - In This First Commandment!
 - And What It Tells Us:
 - About God!
 - And We Learned About The True Nature:
 - Of God!
 - His Exclusive Nature!
 - His Exalted Nature!
 - His Expressive Nature! And:
 - His Eternal Nature!
 - And As John Gill Once Described "For There Is But One Only Living And True God, The Former And Maker Of All Things, Who Only Is To Be Had, Owned, Acknowledged, Served, And Worshiped As Such!"
- 3. Well Tonight:
 - We Are Going To Look At:
 - Why God Gave Us This Command!
 - And In Terms Of 2 Timothy 3:16:
 - God Gave Us This Command:
 - "For Reproof" As Well As "For Doctrine!"
 - "Reproof" Means:
 - To Convict Someone & To Convince Someone:
 - Of The Error Of Their Ways!
 - **IE:** In Our System Of Justice Suspects Of Crimes Are Supposed To Be "Presumed Innocent" Unless & Until There Is Suitable Proof & Evidence Presented For Their Crimes! Unfortunately This Does Not Always Happen In A Court Of Law!
 - But In The Court Of God:
 - He Uses This Commandment:
 - To Provide The Basis Of The Evidence:
 - That We Are Not Innocent! And:
 - That, In And Of Ourselves, We Are Not Righteous Before God!
- 4. According To Isaiah 53:6:
 - "All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way!"
 - We Have Chosen:
 - To Follow Our Own Way:
 - And Our Own Path:
 - Instead of God's Way:
 - And God's Path!
 - And This Choice:
 - Is Sin!
 - But One Of The Problems Is:
 - That We Either Don't **Know** This:
 - Or We Don't Care!
 - And This Is Why God Gave Us This First Commandment As Well As:
 - All Of The Other Ones!

- To Reprove Us!
 - To Convict Us!
 - And To Convince Us:

1. Of Our Failure!

- Our Failure To Obey!
- You See We Are Commanded By God:
 - To "Have No Other Gods Before Me" Because:
 - There Is Only One True God!
 - And He Alone:
 - Is Worthy Of Our Honor!
 - To Honor:
 - His Wonder As God!
 - As Well As:
 - His Will, His Word:
 - And His Way!
 - But What Have We Done?
 - Again Isaiah 53:6:
 - "We Have Turned Every One To His Own Way!"
 - And We Have Failed:
 - To Honor Him:
 - The Way He Deserves And:
 - The Way He Demands!
 - "Thou Shalt Have No Other Gods Before Me!"
 - Wasn't This The Essence:
 - Of The Very First Sin Committed:
 - By Our Earliest Parents Adam And Eve?
 - Let's Look Back:
 - At Their Account:
 - In Genesis 3:1-7 "Now the serpent was more subtil than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said unto the woman, Yea, hath God said, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden? / And the woman said unto the serpent, We may eat of the fruit of the trees of the garden: / But of the fruit of the tree which is in the midst of the garden, God hath said, Ye shall not eat of it, neither shall ye touch it, lest ye die. / And the serpent said unto the woman, Ye shall not surely die: / For God doth know that in the day ye eat thereof, then your eyes shall be opened, and ye shall be as gods, knowing good and evil. / And when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree to be desired to make one wise, she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat, and gave also unto her husband with her; and he did eat. / And the eyes of them both were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together, and made themselves aprons!"
 - When Adam & Eve Sinned:
 - They Failed To Honor The One True God As The God & As Their God!
 - They Failed:
- To Honor The Word Of God!
 - Both The Devil & Adam & Eve:
 - Knew Full Well What God Said:
 - About The Fruit Of The Trees In The Garden! 2:16-17 "And the LORD God commanded the man, saying, Of every tree of the garden thou mayest freely eat: / But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die!"
 - But When The Serpent Questioned God's Word:
 - Both Eve And Then Adam:
 - Did So As Well! They Questioned! They Doubted!
 - 3:1 "Yea, Hath God Said?"
 - And Then They Disobeyed God's Word And Dishonored God Himself!
 They Also Failed:
- To Honor The Will Of God!
 - Why Did God Forbid Them To Eat Of The Fruit:
 - Of That Tree?

- Was There Something Magical In It:
 - As The "Tree Of The Knowledge Of Good And Evil?"
 - Most Likely Not!
- God Was Testing His Creation!
 - To See If They Would:
 - Follow After His Will:
 - And Not Their Own!
- But Once Again:
 - They Failed!
 - And So Do We!
 - Any-Time And Every-Time:
 - We Turn To Our "Own Way!"
- They Also Failed:
- To Honor The Wonder Of God!
 - One Of The Ways The Devil:
 - Tempted Adam & Eve:
 - Was To Appeal To Wonder Of God!
 - In Genesis 3:5 He Said:
 - "For God doth know that in the day ye eat thereof, then your eyes shall be opened, and ye shall be as gods, knowing good and evil!"
 - And When They Heard These Words:
 - It Was Not Enough:
 - For Them To Let God Be God:
 - And Be Content With His Wonderful Wisdom & Ways!
 - No They Wanted To Be Gods:
 - Themselves!
 - To Know:
 - What God Knew!
 - And To Be:
 - What God Was!
 - And So They Failed!
 - They Failed To Honor God:
 - In All Of These Ways!
- But It Was After Adam & Eve Sinned:
 - That God Gave Us The First Commandment!
 - Why? Because We Still Fail:
 - To Honor God The Way We Should!
 - If There Was No Fall:
 - There In The Garden And:
 - If There Was No Failure:
 - In Our Lives:
 - There Would Not Have Been A Need For This Commandment!
- And So Through This Command:
 - God Is Holding Up A Mirror:
 - To Your Heart & To My Heart:
 - So We Can See What It Really Looks Like!
 - We Are All Guilty:
 - Of Failing:
 - To Honor God!
 - And We All Need:
 - To Seek God's Forgiveness:
 - That Can Be Only Found:
 - In The Gospel!
 - In Jesus You Can Receive:
 - Forgiveness & Freedom:
 - From Breaking God's Commandment!

^{*} God Also Uses This Command - To Reprove & Convict Us:

2. Of Our Foolishness!

- We Are Also Commanded By God:
 - To "Have No Other Gods Before Me" Because:
 - There Are No Other Gods!
 - But What Do We Do?
 - We Set Up Other Gods:
 - "Before" Him!
 - And In Opposition To Him!
 - But What Are These:
 - "Other Gods"?
 - A God Is Someone Or Something You Set Up As The Supreme Deity In Your Life!
 - And Worthy Of Your Supplication, Submission, And Service!
 - A Heart Idol:
 - Is No Less An Idol:
 - Than One Made Out Of:
 - Wood Or Stone!
 - And As Martin Luther Once Said:
 - "My Heart Must Not Build Upon Anything Or Trust In Any Other Thing, Be It Wealth, Prestige, Wisdom, Might, Piety, Or Anything Else!"
 - Because Doing So:
 - Makes These All Idols To You!
 - So Tonight What "Other Gods" Do You Have:
 - In Your Heart?
 - The Temptations Abound! So:
 - Where Does Your Love & Trust:
 - Lie? In:

- The God Of Persons?
 - As Paul Describes For Us:
 - In 2 Timothy 3:1-2 "This know also, that in the last days perilous times shall come. / For men shall be lovers of their own selves!"
 - Of Course This Is:
 - The Primary God:
 - Of Our Lives Because:
 - Even When Someone Made An Image & And An Image:
 - To Worship They Were Often Made After The Image Of Man!
 - Are You Your Own God?
 - If & When You Go Your "Own Way" Then:
 - You Are Whether You Like:
 - To Admit To It Or Not!
 - Or What About:
- The God Of Possessions?
 - In 2 Timothy 3:2 The Very Next Word We Come To:
 - Is "Covetous!"
 - This Is The Greedy Desire:
 - For What Other People Have!
 - This Is Also Found In:
 - The Tenth Commandment:
 - "Thou Shalt Not Covet!"
 - But What Is Covetousness?
 - It Is Just Another Form:
 - Of Idolatry!
 - As Paul Tells Us In Ephesians 5:5 "For this ye know, that no whoremonger, nor unclean person, nor covetous man, who is an idolater, hath any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and of God!"
 - Are You Living:
 - Just For The Possessions:
 - That This Life Has To Offer?
 - Then Possessions Are Your God! Whether Those Possessions Belong To You

Or To Others!

- They Are Your God!
- And It Is Foolishness:
 - To Live For Something:
 - That Will Not Last!
- Remember The Words Of Jesus:
 - In Matthew 6:19-21 "Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon earth, where moth and rust doth corrupt, and where thieves break through and steal: / But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break through nor steal: / For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also!"
 - Or What About:
- The God Of Pleasure?
 - In 2 Timothy 3:3-4 Paul Continues:
 - "Without natural affection, trucebreakers, false accusers, incontinent, fierce, despisers of those that are good, / Traitors, heady, highminded, lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God!"
 - When You Love Pleasurable Things:
 - For The Way They Make You Feel:
 - More Than God:
 - Then They Become Another God To You!
 - There Are Certain Natural Appetites:
 - That God Has Given To Us:
 - As Human Beings That Can Be:
 - Quite Pleasurable And Enjoyable!
 - Like The Appetites:
 - For Food And For Leisure And For Companionship And For Love!
 - And In & Of Themselves These Appetites Are Not Sinful!
 - After All:
 - In 1 Timothy 6:17 We Are Told That:
 - The "Living God" Is The One "Who Giveth Us Richly All Things To Enjoy!"
 - But When You Enjoy Those Pleasures:
 - So Much That They Lead You:
 - Outside Of The Boundaries:
 - God Has Set For Them:
 - Then Your Appetites & Pleasures Become Your God!
 - Remember That Even Those Pleasures:
 - Are Passing! And So:
 - As The Apostle John Tells Us "Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him. / For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world. / And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: but he that doeth the will of God abideth for ever!" (1 John 2:15-16)
 - Or What About:
- The God Of Perception?
 - Even When You *Think* You Are:
 - Honoring God But Perceive Him:
 - In Other Ways:
 - Than The Way He Truly Is:
 - You Have Made Him Into Another God!
 - Remember When:
 - The Children Of Israel Were At The Foot Of Mount Sinai Waiting For Moses:
 - To Come Down With God's Law?
 - The Very Same Ten Commandments That We Are Looking At!
 - What Did They Do?
 - Exodus 32:1-8 "And when the people saw that Moses delayed to come down out of the mount, the people gathered themselves together unto Aaron, and said unto him, Up, make us gods, which shall go before us; for as for this Moses, the man that brought us up out of the land of Egypt, we wot not what is become of him. / 2 And Aaron said unto them, Break off the golden earrings, which are in the ears of your wives, of your sons, and of your daughters, and bring them unto me. / 3 And all the people brake off the

golden earrings which were in their ears, and brought them unto Aaron. / 4 And he received them at their hand, and fashioned it with a graving tool, after he had made it a molten calf: and they said, These be thy gods, O Israel, which brought thee up out of the land of Egypt. / 5 And when Aaron saw it, he built an altar before it; and Aaron made proclamation, and said, To morrow is a feast to the LORD, / 6 And they rose up early on the morrow, and offered burnt offerings, and brought peace offerings; and the people sat down to eat and to drink, and rose up to play. / 7 And the LORD said unto Moses, Go, get thee down; for thy people, which thou broughtest out of the land of Egypt, have corrupted themselves: / 8 They have turned aside quickly out of the way which I commanded them: they have made them a molten calf, and have worshipped it, and have sacrificed thereunto, and said, These be thy gods, O Israel, which have brought thee up out of the land of Egypt!"

                         - Thought They Could Make God:
                                 - Into An Image:
                                         - That Was Visible To Them & In A Form That Was More Familiar To
                                         Them! A Golden Calf!
                - And Then - They Claimed:
                         - That This Image:
                                 - Was God! And - Was The Lord!
                                         - But - In Reality - It Was Another God Of Their Own Making!
        - And When We Think Of God:
                - In Ways That He Is Not:
                         - It Is - In Reality:
                                 - Another God We Have Made!
                                         - And - Another God We Worship!
        - But - How Do We Do This?
                - When We De-Emphasize:
                         - Any Of His Glory & His Attributes:
                                 - As God! Or:
                - When We Add Something:
                         - To His Nature:
                                 - That He Has Not Revealed:
                                         - To Us!
- If Any Of These Things:
        - Take The Place Of - Or:
                - Get In The Way Of:
                         - God - And:
                                 - His Wonder, His Will, His Word, His Wisdom, And His Worship:
                                         - Then - We Are Fools!
        - And - We Are Sinning Against God:
                - And His Command!
                         - And - In Doing So:
                                 - We Are The Ones Missing Out & Losing Out On Him!
        - When Adam & Eve Sinned:
                - They - "Hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God amongst the trees of the garden!"
                         - But - Were They Really Hidden?
                                 - No! Of Course Not!
                                         - But They Changed The Truth Of God Into A Lie!
                - And They Thought:
                         - They Could Actually Hide:
                                 - From The Omnipresent Eyes:
                                         - Of God!
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Conclusion:

- This Is Always What Happens:
 - When You Have "Other Gods Before" God!
 - You Will Forget:
 - Who The True God Is:
 - And What He Is Like!

- 2. Now Is This Something:
 - That Is Still Possible:
 - For Us? Even As:
 - Christians & Bible Believers?
 - Unfortunately I'm Afraid So!
 - We See This Taking Place:
 - Once Again In The Children Of Israel:
 - In 2 Kings 17:33 Where We Are Told That:
 - "They feared the LORD, and served their own gods, after the manner of the nations whom they carried away from thence!"
 - "They Feared The Lord, And Served Their Own Gods!"
 - What A Sad Statement!
 - Of Course, Their Fear Of God Was A False Fear!
 - Because As Jesus Would Later Say "No Man Can Serve Two Masters!" (Matthew 6:24)
- 3. But Is This What Is Going On:
 - In Your Life?
 - Is There Someone Or Something Else:
 - That Is A Rival To God:
 - On The Throne Of Your Heart?
 - Any Other Person?
 - Any Other Possession?
 - Any Other Pleasure?
 - Or Any Other Perception Of God?
- 4. This Is Why God Continues:
 - To Confront Us & Reprove Us:
 - With The First Commandment:
 - For Our Tendency To Sin:
 - In This Way!
 - "Thou shalt have no other gods before me!" (Exodus 20:3)
 - And This Is Why:
 - You Need To Return:
 - To The Lord Our God:
 - Daily & Even Moment By Moment!
 - And Love Him Supremely!
 - With All Of Your Heart, Mind, Soul, And Strength!
 - So Let Us Close With The Same Words:
 - The Apostle Paul Wrote To The Corinthian Church:
 - In 1 Corinthians 10:4:
 - "Wherefore, my dearly beloved, flee from idolatry!"
- * Are You Honoring God As God In Your Life?
- * Is There Something Or Someone That Is Taking God's Place In Your Heart?
- * By God's Grace & With His Help:
 - Will You Flee From All Forms Of Idolatry Beginning Tonight?

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
