Bottom Line:

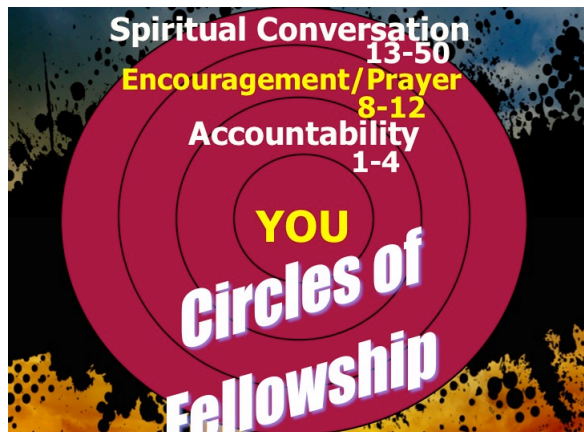
Real faith in Christ values people the way God values them and refuses to show favoritism based on external worldly values.

1. Right thinking about \_\_\_\_\_ leads to right thinking about each other. James 2:1

Favoritism:

Showing partiality based on appearance, status, or the potential of receiving a benefit in return.

2. Wrong \_\_\_\_\_ occur when we wrongly judge one another. James 2:2-7



A. See the \_\_\_\_\_ that come with those who lack in resources. v. 5

B. See the \_\_\_\_\_ that come with those who are well resourced. v. 6

3. Right thinking about \_\_\_\_\_ encourages right decisions about rejecting it. James 2:8-13

A. Pursue the \_\_\_\_\_ of doing well in God's eyes. v. 8-9

B. Remember the reality that we are \_\_\_\_\_ for our actions. v. 10-13
