

- 1) How can I best prepare to remember the death of Christ and celebrate His resurrection this week?
- 2) Is there any basis for the claim that the four resurrection narratives (Matthew, Mark, Luke and John) contradict each other?
- 3) In what way was Christ “the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep” (1 Cor. 15:20, NKJV)?
- 4) How could any believers be doubtful of the resurrection (cf. Matt. 28:17; 1 Cor. 15:6)?
- 5) Forty days after His resurrection, the Lord Jesus ascended to heaven. What did He do during those 40 days (cf. Acts 1:3)?
- 6) Sometimes I feel that my service to God is inadequate and even begin to doubt my relationship with the Lord. Does this mean that I may not be saved?
- 7) Can the saints in heaven intercede for believers upon the earth today?
- 8) How would you guide a younger child in studying their Bible? What are some of the first books of the Bible they might read through, and are there study helps they might start getting acquainted with?
- 9) Can we know the season of Christ’s return, even if we cannot know the “day and hour” (Matt. 24:36)?
- 10) The Apostles’ Creed says that when Christ died “He descended into hell.” What does that mean?
