PERGAMUM: COURAGEOUS BUT COMPROMISED - Rev 2:12-17

022821P INTRODUCTION

- 1. Opposition in Smyrna from synagogue of Satan [Rv 2:9]. Opposition in Pergamum is pagan where Satan's throne is 2:12-17.
- 2. Famous library; pagan temples & Emperor cult each deity called "savior" "kurios kairos" Lord Caesar. How hard cld it be to say 2 simple words?
- 3. Roman gov't cld execute death sentence in thoroughly paganized courts.

1st: The Address and the Author - <u>v12</u>

- 1. Angel church seen in spiritual war [human/angelic] exercise authority. You [v13ff] is single [tho plural in v13]: individual martyr united to church.
 - i. Jesus writes to churches. Satan opposes churches.
 - ii. When we encounter lax churchmanship by professing Christians, we have reason to perceive a Satanic strategy at work.
- 2. <u>1:16</u> 2:12. Roman court had power of sword Jesus has sword [Hb 4:12].
 - i. <u>Rv 19:15</u> assoc'd w/ judgment _
 - ii. <u>Rv 2:16</u> threatens false teachers *sword of His mouth* = Word of God

2nd: The Evaluation of the Spiritual Condition of Smyrna - v13

- 1. Commends present & past: holding fast & did not deny My name/faith
- 2. *I know where you dwell* among whom you live different locations & historical settings pose different challenges to the church Tit 1:10-14. *I know*= knowledge gained by experience: Jesus lived in Satan's realm.
- 3. where Satan's throne is: Satan rules Pergamum: murderous lies; immoral behavior; idolatrous enforced by the civil/court authorities
- 4. *holding fast* & proved faithful when *Antipas* was martyred = *My witness*, *My faithful one* <u>2:10b</u> faithful til death -> crown of life.
 - i. Antipas ["against-all"]. We do not know how he died Jesus knows.
 - ii. *faithful witness* to Jesus: My [2x]: name witness
 - -0iii. who was killed among you [plural]
- 5. *Where Satan dwells = where you dwell*: Satan & church live in same place

3rd: Words of Praise or Reproof - <u>v14-15</u>

- 1. I have a few thgs against you: church is fighting [Anitpas: faithful witness] But against compromise
 - i. Cf Waldensians persecuted in Reformation, now liberal
 - ii. Perg saw Antipas martyred but is now doctrinally compromised.
- 2. Orthodox [you hold fast My name] but tolerating teaching [2x] that is identified w/ Balaam & associated w/ Nicolaitans.
 - i. v15 Nicolaitans in the same way as Balaam [v14] doctrine & practice
 - ii. Balak & Balaam Num 22-25. Balaam enticed Israel to idolatry & immorality = covenant infidelity. Religion as a business selling sensual & material gratification socially celebrated.
 - iii. Nicolaitans *stumbling block ->* apostasy. *You have* [v14,15] TF Jesus says *I have*.
 - a. Perhaps involvement in pagan celebrations were said to be a "liberty" a legitimate engagement w/ society: no harm done.
 - b. Temptations to Xns converted from paganism [A 15:29; cf. Cor 1C 8:1-10; 10:14-33].
 - iv. Jesus is against Nicolaitans [KJV adds wh/ I hate] 2:6 Ephesus is commended where Pergamum is rebuked.

4th: Words of Exhortation - v16

- 1. The Nics must be removed either by church or by Jesus. *Repent* this teaching [those teaching] must go.
- 2. Jesus' coming to make war against them w/ sword from mouth

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- i. Providential judgment? cf. <u>1C 11:30-32</u>; 1C 3:17a; Hab 3
- ii. Jesus' 2-edged sword obeyed by church to discipline & remove.
- iii. Ananias & Sapphira [A5]: compromise/apostasy is very dangerous.

5th: Command to Hear What the Spirit Says - v17a

- 1. Repent or else I will come hear what Spirit says: circum'd ears Jer 6:10
- 2. We need intentional listening Prv 2:1-2 listen, pray, study, implement; avoid perverse man [v12], adulteress [v16]. 2 Women: Wisdom or Folly.

6th: Promises to the Overcomer - <u>v17b</u>

- 1. hidden manna food for wilderness [Jn 6:48-51]
- 2. white stone juror's vote to acquit; to admit into feast of Asclepios Jesus overturns black-stone of condemnation & admits to Lamb's banquet Rv 19
- 3. <u>new name $\underline{\text{Rv} 3:12}$ => identified w/ Jesus & His glory</u>
- 4. Known only to recipient? [Rv 19:12-13] Private, intimate, personal. Lk 10:22; Rv 22:4
- 5. v13 hold fast My name inclusio [v17] given new name: My new name.
