Nicene Creed

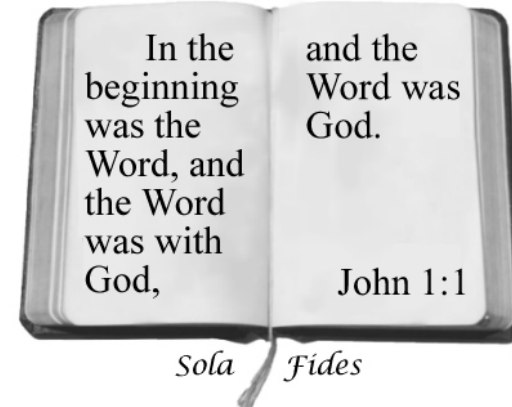
