## "THE PATTERN FOR PRAYER"

## **Matthew 6:7-15**

## INTRODUCTION:

\*Let Jesus teach you about prayer.

- I. Don't pray . . . this way (6:5-8)
  - A. Don't pray to impress men (v. 5-6)
  - B. Don't pray to impress <u>God</u> (v. 7-8)
- II. Pray this way (6:9-15)

Follow Christ's model, example, outline, or pattern of prayer:

- A. Pray for God to be <u>glorified</u> (v. 9-10) [Adoration]
  - 1. God's <u>pre-eminence</u> (His Name) (v. 9 "Hallowed be Thy Name")
  - 2. God's <u>program</u> (His Kingdom) (v. 10 "Thy Kingdom come")
  - 3. God's plan (His will) (v. 10b "Thy will be done")
- B. Pray for God to meet our <u>needs</u> (v. 11-15) [Petition]
  - 1. God's <u>provision</u> (Pray about the <u>needs</u> of our <u>present</u>) "Give us this day our daily bread" (v. 11)
  - 2. God's <u>pardon</u> (Pray about the <u>failures</u> of our <u>past</u>) "Forgive us our debts" (v. 12)
  - 3. God's <u>protection</u> (Pray about the <u>dangers</u> or our <u>future</u> "Lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil"

CONCLUSION: God's <u>Praise</u> ("Thine is the Kingdom. . . power. . . glory. . . forever, Amen.") Verse 13b
