#### **Not Ashamed**

## Romans 1:16 - I am not ashamed of the Gospel...

## 1) Shame

- a) Relates to what a certain community values,
- b) Feeling of shame is a measure of how badly you want to belong to that community.

## 2) Dispelling False Shames

- a) Your Gospel is Parochial (not for everyone)
- b) Your Gospel is Novel
- c) Your Gospel is Common

#### 3) Rejecting True (but Rebel) Shames

a) Your Gospel Exclusively Saves

v. 16 – it is THE power of God for salvation! v. 17 – For in IT, the righteousness of God is revealed... In IT, and nowhere else.

## b) Your Gospel Brings Suffering

Romans 1:16-17, Pt 2

Paul doesn't argue with the fact that the Gospel will bring difficult changes to life, and with it a measure of suffering.

...Suffering from the world who not only shames, but often even turns violently on Christians... 1 Thess 2:14-16; Heb 10:32-33;

...Suffering internally – a great wrestling of soul to try to live for Christ when my flesh, and the world, and the devil himself are all against me. Gal 5:16-17, Rom 7:21-24

...Suffering common to man - there is no guarantee that I still won't have physical pain, disease, financial setbacks, broken relationships. 2 Cor 4:16, 5:2; Rom 8:22-23,19-21; **1 Pt 2:18-20** 

Rom 8:18 – I consider the sufferings of this present time not worthy to be compared with the glory that is to be revealed to us.

v. 16 - ... it is the power of God for SALVATION! v. 17 - ... the righteous by faith shall LIVE!

## c) Your Gospel Can't be Proven

Or, "it must be believed by Faith."

v. 16 – salvation to everyone who <u>believes</u> v. 17 – in it the righteousness of God is revealed <u>from faith to faith</u>, and "the righteous by faith shall live."

## 4) Why Salvation by Faith is No Shame

- 1. Evidence alone won't turn a rebel heart
  - v. 18 ("suppress the truth")

#### 2. Faith is the whole point!

God created mankind for the Obedience of Faith, not the Obedience of Sight.

Adam and Eve...

Abraham...

Jesus... Luke 16:31, John 20:29

Paul... - Acts 28:23-24, 1 Cor 2:5, Rom 1:5

# 3. God Himself shows up to do the convincing

Paul in many ways expresses this glorious truth, but none more clearly than in 2 Cor 4:3-6 ...

- 3. 1 Peter presents 3 types of suffering: in spite of doing good (2:18-20), for doing good (3:13-17), for being a Christian (4:14-16). How do the surrounding verses teach you to respond?
- 4. If more evidence / reasoning won't change a rebel heart, what helpful purposes might there be for still providing evidences to someone?
- 5. How might you respond if someone scoffs that you cannot prove the Gospel is true?
