I. Blessed be the Father who has Blessed us in Christ (1:3-6)

a. preposition "in" specifies our union with Christ: historical events Crucifixion, resurrection and ascension

b. dative case: sense of 'through Christ' - our location, where Christ is

c. dative case: identity - 'in Adam' now we are 'in Christ' our identity

1. We are in heaven with Christ (1:3b)

has blessed us [past tense] in the heavenly realms with every spiritual blessing" (v.3) cf. 1:20; 2:6

- 2. Blessed with Christ's Status (1:4,5)
  - a) Christ's Sanctity (v.4)
  - b) Christ's Sonship (v.5)
- 3. Blessed through Christ Alone (1:4–6)

a) Salvation is a Gift that is ours without Human Cause at All (1:5)

b) Salvation comes through Divine Love Alone (1:6)
