WE APPROACH THE LORD

Prelude Call to Worship

The rationale for this psalm's call to praise is the implied fact that God judges the wicked and preserves, blesses, and protects those who love and obey His commandments.

Psalm 112 ESV

- Praise the LORD!
 - Blessed is the man who fears the LORD, who greatly delights in his commandments!
- ² His offspring will be mighty in the land; the generation of the upright will be blessed.
- ³ Wealth and riches are in his house, and his righteousness endures forever.
- ⁴ Light dawns in the darkness for the upright; he is gracious, merciful, and righteous.
- ⁵ It is well with the man who deals generously and lends; who conducts his affairs with justice.
- ⁶ For the righteous will never be moved; he will be remembered forever.
- ⁷ He is not afraid of bad news; his heart is firm, trusting in the LORD.
- ⁸ His heart is steady; he will not be afraid, until he looks in triumph on his adversaries.
- ⁹ He has distributed freely; he has given to the poor; his righteousness endures forever; his horn is exalted in honor.
- ¹⁰The wicked man sees it and is angry; he gnashes his teeth and melts away; the desire of the wicked will perish!

God's people are commanded to listen to the True Prophet in the line of Moses: Jesus Christ, and to discern between those who rightly represent Him and those who are false prophets.

Deuteronomy 18:15-22 ESV

"The LORD your God will raise up for you a prophet like me from among you, from your brothers it is to him you shall listen 16 just as you desired of the LORD your God at Horeb on the day of the assembly, when you said, 'Let me not hear again the voice of the LORD my God or see this great fire any more, lest I die.' ¹⁷ And the LORD said to me, 'They are right in what they have spoken. 18 I will raise up for them a prophet like you from among their brothers. And I will put my words in his mouth, and he shall speak to them all that I command him. 19 And whoever will not listen to my words that he shall speak in my name, I myself will require it of him. ²⁰ But the prophet who presumes to speak a word in my name that I have not commanded him to speak, or who speaks in the name of other gods, that same prophet shall die.' 21 And if you say in your heart, 'How may we know the word that the LORD has not spoken?' 22 when a prophet speaks in the name of the LORD, if the word does not come to pass or come true, that is a word that the LORD has not spoken; the prophet has spoken it presumptuously. You need not be afraid of him.

Silent Confession of Sin

Corporate Confession of Sin

The focus of this confession is the failure to know, cherish, and promote God's truth in all of our spheres of influence, as well as publicly oppose all that is against it.

Almighty Father, Who by your will and for your glory formed us and everything else in all creation, Who upholds all things by the power of your Word, and Who has graciously and lovingly preserved your people and provided for our needs, we confess our constant failure to trust You and rely upon your goodness. Instead of leaning wholly upon You, we have thought and acted upon the meager understanding afforded by our limited human perspectives. Rather than acknowledging You in all our ways, we have forgotten You and turned to our own way, the way that seems right unto a man, but leads to death. We have failed to take seriously and oppose the challenges to your truth and Word which we have experienced in our culture, thus either tacitly acceding to them or allowing them to flourish by our silence. We have sinned against You constantly by presuming to own ourselves and our ways, in violation of your holy command to trust You with all of our hearts. With renewed faith we cast ourselves upon Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith, Who gave himself for us to redeem us from all wickedness. In abject sorrow we confess our unbelief, and in heartfelt and sincere repentance ask You for the grace of faith, wrought by your Holy Spirit, which You have promised to give your people Israel. Write your law on our hearts, that we may adopt your heart and mind, and evermore walk in the light, as You are in the light, through Jesus Christ, the Light of the world. Amen.

Assurance of Pardoning Grace

"Walking in the light," a scriptural way of referring to living according to God's revealed truth, is an indication that the atoning blood of Jesus applies to us, as well as being the basis for fellowship with others who are united to Him by faith.

I John 1:5–7 ESV

This is the message we have heard from him and proclaim to you, that God is light, and in him is no darkness at all. ⁶ If we say we have fellowship with him while we walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth. ⁷ But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of lesus his Son cleanses us from all sin.

Leader: This is the gospel. Congregation: Hallelujah!

Distribution of Elements

Because we believe that wine was used in the Last Supper and is thus more in accord with the fullness of symbolism intended by God in the Lord's Supper, we offer wine and encourage those who take part in Communion to take this. For those with conscientious convictions against the use of wine, however, we offer the option of grape juice, which is contained in the inner circle of the communion trays. The cups containing wine are in the outer circles of the trays.
