- The Christian life can be simplified to this one law or command.
- II. This is the summarizing word for the Christian life because this kind of life reflects the love of God.

The Golden Rule for Loving the Neighbor

- The Beautiful Idea
 - A. To understand rightly the golden rule, we must see that Jesus addressed this command to citizens of the kingdom of heaven.

- B. What is Jesus teaching us in this command?
 - 1. First, He is teaching us to think of others.
 - Second, Jesus emphasizes activity we are called to do things for each other from this perspective: what would you like others to do for you if the table was turned?
- II. The Biblical Source
 - A. Jesus is saying that this summarizes the law and the prophets. This is what the OT was teaching.

- B. The law and the prophets empower us to follow this golden rule.
- III. The Necessary Life
 - A. The golden rule is tied to the preceding verses with the word "therefore." We must do this because this reflects the love God shows to us in Christ Jesus.
 - B. The principle of the Christian life is simple, but not easy.
