
THE ANSWER TO LIFE'S GREATEST QUESTION Ecclesiastes 2:12-26 Sermon 4

II.	Yo	u won't find satisfaction in work (2:18-23).
	A.	2:18b-19 = ARGUMENT #1—"Life is [not] made by working to provide for one's children, or, more generally, for 'posterity'" (Garrett, <i>NAC</i> , 295).
	В.	2:20 = ARGUMENT #2—Striving to gain satisfaction out of one's will only lead to ""!
	C.	2:21 = ARGUMENT #3—It's not just wealth, even the and that a person develops by working hard cannot produce lasting fulfillment.
	D.	2:22-23 = ARGUMENT #4—An between work and life will leave a man deeply in his soul.
Transition	: Aft	er a lifetime of research, Solomon draws this conclusion
III.	Yo	u will find satisfaction in Christ alone!
	A.	How can a believer go from hating life to finding deep fulfillment and satisfaction?
	В.	2:24 = ANSWER #1—You will find in the pursuits of life—especially the little things—if you are serving God with all your heart, soul, mind, and strength rather than self!
	C.	2:24 = ANSWER #2— you have can bring joy because it is a gift "from the hand of God."
	D.	2:25 = ANSWER #3—Everything we do "apart from him" will leave us!
	E.	2:26 = ANSWER #4—True will come to the one who lives (reads) life the right way, but will come to the one who lives life the wrong way!
