## JESUS THE HEALER

I. He is the compassionate Healer II. He is the capable Healer

## I. THE LORD JESUS IS THE COMPASSIONATE HEALER

A. What does *compassion* mean?

- B. In Bible story we meet a few compassionate friends: vs. 32 1. Who did they bring to Jesus?
  - 2. Why did they bring him to Jesus?
  - 3. Are we/will we be such compassionate friends?
- C. They brought this boy/man the best address: *a compassionate Jesus!* 1. How did Jesus show His compassion?
  - a. sometimes He wept or touched/allowed touch or talked

b. in this case He sighed (vs. 34)

- D. This sigh of Jesus is His sermon about God 1. This sigh reveals more of Father's heart than words can say
  - 2. What a hope-giving truth is heard in this sigh of Jesus!a. though we angered God with our sins, He sent His Son to save sinners
    - b. though we grieved God with sin, He is grieved seeing our sufferings
  - 3. Are we resembling this sighing Jesus?

## **II. THE LORD JESUS IS THE CAPABLE HEALER**

- A. This boy or man might have felt embarrassed or shameful about his speech
  - 1. Do you ever feel embarrassed about not *speaking well?* a. about our sinful *talking*?
    - b. about our sinful not talking?

B. We are like this boy/man more than what we might realize

- 1. We all have become deaf to God's voice or message
  - a. We were not deaf for God in Paradise
  - b. Are you still deaf to God's voice in His Law, Gospel or even in nature?
    - do you hear the *thunder* in God's law?
    - do you hear the *music* in God's Gospel?
    - do you hear the *calling* in God's providence?
    - do you hear the *sweetness* in God's people's talking?

D. Are you asking...

- 1. What can I do about this being deaf and unable to speak well?
- 2. Where must I go with this problem?
