For us to extend God's grace to others:

1. We must recognize God's grace in our own lives.

Gen. 45:1-2

Application: Wait patiently for God.

2. We must embrace God's sovereignty. Gen. 45:5-9

Application: Rest in the fact that God is in control.

3. We must display humility. Gen 45:1

a. Forgive people privately. Gen. 45:1

Application: Do not embarrass your offender publicly or bring any recognition to yourself.

b. Take no credit for where we are today. Gen. 45:9b

Application: Exalt God, not ourselves.

4. Extend forgiveness. Gen. 45:4-5

Application: Don't be afraid to name the offense and forgive it.

5. Release others. Gen. 45:8a

Application: Let others know that God is in control, not them.

6. Bless our offender. Gen. 45:10-11

Application: Let God's grace flow through us.
