#### **God sends His Servant v 26**

What is Philip doing now? What does God tell him to do?

Philip immediately obeyed.

Be willing and available to serve God when the opportunity arises.

### God prepares His Child v 27-28

The Old Testament faith was an inclusive faith.

It looked beyond Israel to the nations. (1 Kings 8:41-43; Jeremiah 29:13)

Where is Ethiopia?

Who was Candace?

He was perhaps the first African Convert.

Encouragement for a Eunuch. Isaiah 56:3-7.

## God brings His Word, His Servant and His Child together v 29-31

Do you understand what you are reading? (Romans 10:12-15)

God will move heaven and earth to reach one of his children.

# God presents Christ to His child through His servant v 32-35

Philip preaches Christ to him from Isa 53.

Where is v 37?

Baptism is a sign and seal from God that you are included in the covenant and promises of God.
