## "HIS OATH, HIS COVENANT" The Preservation of God's Beloved People Deuteronomy 29: 1 - 9 February 7, 2021

"But to this day the LORD has not given you a heart to understand" (Deuteronomy 29: 4)

To fully understand God's preservation of His people means that God Himself has moved upon us by His own good pleasure and given us understanding where we had none.

- 1. Much of evangelical thought does not live as those who have been brought into a binding covenant by God Himself. *(The Problem)v.1* (Acts 3:22-26)
- 2. God; however, has revealed Himself to us and given understanding to us as to who He is and the covenant He has called us into. *(The Correction) v. 2* 
  - a. <u>God has already revealed Himself to us in many undeniable ways vv.2b-3</u> (Rom 9:15-17)
  - <u>God MUST however open our understanding to what He has revealed v.4</u> (Matt 13:11-15) will you
  - c. <u>ONLY in God's opening our minds will we recognize His divine work</u>
    - i. We can recognize God's promised provision v.6
    - ii. We can recognize God's promised protection v.7
    - iii. We can recognize God's promised presence v.8

(Matt 10:7-10)

3. We MUST remember that God's covenant is not an informal, lose agreement, but one of binding authority and promise. *(The Follow Through)* v.9 (John 6:37)
