IV. The Writing above the Cross -- Matthew 27:37

A. All Four Gospels tell us of the writing above the Cross.

Matthew: This is Jesus...The King of the Jews.

Mark: The King of the Jews

Luke: This is...The King of the Jews.

John: ...Jesus of Nazareth, The King of the Jews.

Put it all together: This is Jesus of Nazareth, the King of the Jews.

B. Pilates Motive – John 19:19-22

JESUS OF NAZARETH, THE KING OF THE JEWS.

 $^{^{19}}$ Now Pilate wrote a title and put it on the cross. And the writing was:

²⁰ Then many of the Jews read this title, for the place where Jesus was crucified was near the city; and it was written in Hebrew, Greek, *and* Latin.

²¹ Therefore the chief priests of the Jews said to Pilate, "Do not write, 'The King of the Jews,' but, 'He said, "I am the King of the Jews." '"

²² Pilate answered, "What I have written, I have written."
