2076 - BE ALERT - Acts 20:29-32

PRELIMS. Paul is addressing Ephn elders at Miletus on his way to Jerusalem. He has told them he will not see them again! He emphasised the importance of looking after **their own souls** before they could *take care for the Church of God* [28]

Again Paul is **prophetic**, he **knows** what is going to happen to **them after** he leaves them! Being an Apostle who had extra-ordinary revelations and experiences and on one occasions being *caught up into paradise*! [2C12:3] he had an **advantage** that not many pastors today have. He was therefore able to say to them *I know that after my departure fierce wolves will come in among you*, *not sparing the flock* [29] That was must have been very **hard** for **him** to **say** - as well as for **them** to **take**!! But Paul was a **realist** and did **not hold back** from his responsibility to **prepare** his flock for the **future**! **Preparing** for something is **believing** it will happen! (Heaven!)

To what was Paul **referring** when he said 'fierce wolves not sparing the flock'? One imagines **physical** abuse – but it **wasn't!** It was actual **theological heresy!** Which shows the vital **importance** of right doctrine! To be **diverted** from the **truth** is a most serious step. Spiritual injuries are **more** serious than physical injuries – far more serious, because they have **eternal** consequences!

We know it was a spiritual mauling because Paul asked Tim to remain at Ephesus that you may charge certain persons not to teach any different doctrine... Certain person have wandered away into vain discussion [1Tim1:3-6] *The Church continued for at least another 40 yrs after this for in AD90 or so, Jesus spoke to them from heaven and told them to repent! And it was the result of heresy. Men speaking twisted things caused them to turn away from the truth [30]

It **does** seem that what they were taught and what they **believed** thru those who 'came in', **affected** them greatly. It affected how they **lived**! Jesus **had** to tell them in [Rev 2:4] *you have <u>abandoned</u> the love you had at first* [Rev 2:4] **Love** is **big** in the Bible. (Of course we do not mean the 'Holywood style' of love but 'agape love'). It was love to God, love to Christ that Jesus was referring to – which of course **results**, if genuine, in love to **people** also to the **undeserving!**

Not 'soppy' love but **sacrificial self-denying** love! They lost the first, strong, emotional, love that new believers have to Jesus Christ That was why Paul reminded Tim *The <u>aim</u> of our charge* is <u>love</u> that issues from a pure heart and...sincere faith [1T1:4]

But there was something else, **much more** difficult for Paul to say. It was that 'insiders' would do this destructive work as well - and from among your own selves will arise men speaking twisted things [30] That can happen — Carpetbaggers we used to call them! People joining a group with an ulterior motive! Once they 'get in', they do their own wicked work! Satan agents who infiltrate the church!

You know most **splits** are caused, **not** by 'outsiders' coming in, but from a church's **own members**! Just think of the splits you know about – many started **not** by the outside 'world', but from among the church's members! People become disgruntled. Jealousy/complaints!

Paul told them that the objective of these false teachers was to have **followers**! **to** draw away the disciples after them [30b]. People **love** to be seen as **leaders**. But do you know the main **characteristic** of a **true** leader? It is **not** to have followers it is to spread **truth/good-ness!** It is to **love** the 'Cause' they preach! They are so **convinced** of its **truthfulness** and **goodness**, they are prepared to **lose/suffer/be rejected/be ridiculed** for it! They **hope** they will get followers – but if they do not, so be it! Loss financial or otherwise, does not matter!

So the fierce wolves, by their heretical teaching achieved what their Master Satan planned – to make the Ephs lose their <u>love!</u> Love is the <u>main characteristic</u> of the Xn faith. A fruit of the Spirit! Paul <u>had</u> to write a whole chapter on love. Paul had to go into the **details** of love! Love is *patient* and *kind*; love does not envy or boast; it is not arrogant or rude. It does not insist on its own way; it is not irritable or resentful; it does not rejoice at wrongdoing, but rejoices with the truth [1Cor:13] the greatest of these is love!

Paul's love is further characterised by the <u>tears</u> which he shed for them! Paul's ministry was <u>not</u> simply a <u>declaration</u> of <u>propositional</u> truth – although it most certainly was that. It was a <u>heartfelt</u>, <u>emotional appeal!</u> Eternal destinies were at stake! Thus the <u>admonish everyone</u> with <u>tears</u> for 3yrs! Jesus said <u>As the Father has</u>

loved Me, so have I loved you. Abide in My love [John 15:9] Paul to Philemon yet for love's sake I prefer to appeal to you!

Why did Paul weep for those in the Church? Because they and not the 'world', will have a far greater damnation than those who never heard the gospel! Those who hear and reject, either immediately or later in life, will have a far sorer punishment than those who never heard the gospel! Listen How much worse punishment, do you think, will be deserved by the one who has spurned the Son of God, and has profaned the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified, and has outraged the Spirit of grace? [Heb 10:29] Better for them never to have known the way of righteousness than after knowing it to turn back [2Pet 2:21 That is why baptised people leaving the church is a very very serious thing! Those in covenant with God, who turn away and reject it, will suffer far more!

There is only **one** thing Paul can do apart from pray – that is <u>warn</u> them! *Therefore be <u>alert</u>* [31] Or watch. Jesus said it many times – and to His disciples! Be vigilant. We are in a <u>war</u> and we need to be aware of the danger we are in and that we are vulnerable and 'easy prey' for Satan! *what I say unto you I say unto all, Watch* [Mar 13:37]

Paul now **commends** them to God and to *the word of His grace* [32] Notice, elders are <u>under</u> the Word, not over it! The Word <u>regulates</u> their lives and <u>directs</u> their lives – far less do elders <u>formulate</u> the Word. *The Word of God is a very <u>real thing</u>, but <u>abstract</u> thing. That perhaps makes it more <u>indestructible</u>. It is '<u>established</u> in heaven' *Forever*, *O Lord*, *Your Word is firmly <u>fixed</u> (<u>settled</u>) in heaven* [Psa 119:89] God's Word can either be <u>written</u> or <u>spoken</u>. The Bible is God's written Word <u>canonised</u>! The Canon is what God has <u>recorded</u> to be <u>forever established</u> as His <u>abiding</u> Word to all mankind in all <u>ages</u> and in all <u>cultures</u>! God, of course, has <u>said</u> <u>more</u> than what is in the Canon! God has <u>inspired</u> people to write and speak <u>accurately</u> and <u>powerfully</u> without it being in the Canon! The Canon is forever/unchangeable! Inspired but not canonical!

What a wonderful description Paul gives the Bible *the Word of His* **grace**! That is exactly what the Bible is – it's a marvellous story of **grace** – of **unmerited** favour towards **undeserving** man! *It does

two things: (a) It provides an inheritance! People's hearts have taken a leap when the lawyer says 'Mr Brown, I am pleased to tell you, you have been left an inheritance'!! An inheritance is having a right to tangible property/assets! One can have a right to something but not take possession of it! Esau had a 'right' to his father's inheritance but he sold it! Some people neglect/despise their inheritance! Some inheritances, through delay-lose their value!

However, God's grace is such that not only have we a right to it, but it is *kept in heaven for us* - by God - we are actually **given** *an inheritance that is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading* and the wonderful thing is, it is not kept in the solicitor's files or archives, where it can be lost! Rather it is *kept* in *heaven for you who believe* It is actually **there** – waiting for **you** to arrive in heaven!

Heaven is a far better 'safe' than any bank or lawyers office, because it is kept by *God's power*. It is **not** kept by **human** power. Despite all the technology of our day, nothing is 100% secure. Remember what they said about the **Titanic** 'This ship will never sink – even God Himself could not sink this ship'! You would have thought your money was safe with **Enron!** But it crashed, so did **Northern Rock!**

But **not only** is your inheritance safe – you **personally** are safe also! If you are one of God's chosen people **you** are being **guarded**, you might not **'feel'** it, but you are, so that you **will persevere** and **possess** your possessions through **faith** for a **salvation** ready **to** be revealed in the last time [1 Pet 1:4,5]

ready to be revealed - You know some people are **disappointed** and **shocked** when they gather round the solicitor's office and hear the will read out! They are all 'ready to have it revealed' but get a **shock!** They are shocked because they have been left out or only get a 'pittance' compared to what they expected!

Will the Xn be **disappointed**? He might be, but if they are, it will be that **he/she did not do more** for Jesus Christ! The shock he will get is how **large the inheritance he will get, actually is!** Listen: For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, is **working** for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory [2C4:17 NKJV]. Its **value/worth** has **infinite dimensions**!
