-Acts 9:42 (ESV) And it became known throughout all Joppa, and many believed in the Lord.

-The miracles

-Acts 8:1 (ESV) "...and they were all scattered throughout the regions of Judea and Samaria, except the apostles."

-The continued establishment by God of the apostolic leadership of the church.

-Ephesians 2:20 "...on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus himself being the cornerstone..."

-The glory of Christ

-The purpose/result was that many believed in the Lord.

-We should not seek to be used to perform miracles.

-We should desire to be a fisher of men/women.

-We will be <u>available</u>, <u>responsive</u>, and <u>effective</u>.

-By being in the places where the people were, he was available to be used by the Lord in their lives generally.

-He was available *generally* which positioned and conditioned him to be responsive *particularly*.

-When he was available generally to all, then responsive particularly for the one, his message was most effective with the many.

-The big thing is most often hidden behind the little thing.
