Pastor Kit Culver's sermon and study notes for his John 023 message, "Jesus Encounter with the Samaritan Woman - The Promise of Living Worship" from 1/24/16.

Examine the Scriptures (Be Berean!)

- John 4:1-43

Consider & Discuss (Be Transformed!)

- Recalling the immediate context, why did the Samaritan woman perceive Jesus to be a prophet?
- What history led the Samaritan woman's ancestors and Jesus' ancestors to worship in different places?
- Where did Jesus say was the place she should worship?
- The Samaritans had some knowledge of God, yet Jesus said they worshipped what they did not know. What did they not know (22a)?
- What did Jesus and His ancestors ("we") know that the Samaritan's did not (22b); and what was the basis for their additional knowledge (22c)?
- What is significant about the time reference, "an hour is coming and now is"; and do we live in that same time?
- What is a "true worshipper"; and what does this suggest about "false" worshippers? Is there a warning here?
- What does it mean that God seeks "the true worshippers" to be His worshippers?
- Who is Jesus? What is the significance of that to the Samaritan woman and to us?
- **Community Group Discussion: How do true worshippers now worship? What implications does that have on your individual worship and on our corporate worship?**
