Examine the Scriptures (Be Berean!)

• John 4:1-43

Consider & Discuss (Be Transformed!)

- What may have the disciples been thinking when they saw Jesus speaking with a Samaritan woman (27)?
- Why might the woman have left her water pot at the well (28)?
- What do you make of how she described Jesus (29a) and what she asked about Him (29b)?
- How would you describe the effectiveness of the woman's ministry (30)?
- What is the similarity between the metaphors Jesus employed in 4:7ff and here 4:31ff?
- Initially, how did the Samaritan woman and Jesus' disciples (33) think alike? This indicate a universal problem?
- Unpack Jesus' food metaphor, i.e., as living water was a metaphor for Jesus Himself and the eternal life found in union with Him, and as drinking was a metaphor for believing, what do food and eating indicate here?
- Similarly, unpack Jesus sowing, reaping, harvest metaphor in 35-38 to understand His meaning.
- How did the Samaritans respond to the woman's words in v. 39? In v. 40? To Jesus' words (41)? What did they come to know about Jesus (42)?
- Community Group Discussion: What was Jesus' charge to His disciples (38)? Is this a word for us; and if so, what are we to do about it?
