PUBLIC PROFESSION OF FAITH

The Session has satisfactorily examined **Shiloh Slater** and has previously announced her name to the congregation, giving the congregation ample opportunity to notify the Session of any facts concerning her that may be inconsistent with a sincere profession. Do you openly accept God's covenant promise, which has been signified and sealed unto you in your baptism, and do you confess that you abhor and humble yourself before God because of your sins, and that you seek your life not in yourself, but only in Jesus Christ your Savior?

Do you declare that you love the Lord, and that it is your heartfelt desire to serve Him according to His Word, to forsake the world, to mortify your old nature, and to lead a godly life?

Do you agree to submit, in the Lord, to the government of this church and also, if you should become delinquent either in doctrine or life, to submit to its admonition and discipline.

Minister addressing congregation: [Congregation, please rise.]

Do you, the members of this congregation, promise in the presence of God, to safeguard this covenant, receiving this sister in the Lord into the fellowship of this covenant; both for the edification of her faith and the strengthening of this church; and at all times setting an example of godliness before her so that she may behold, for her comfort, your faithfulness as an encouragement in her walk with the Lord? If so, answer, "We do so promise."

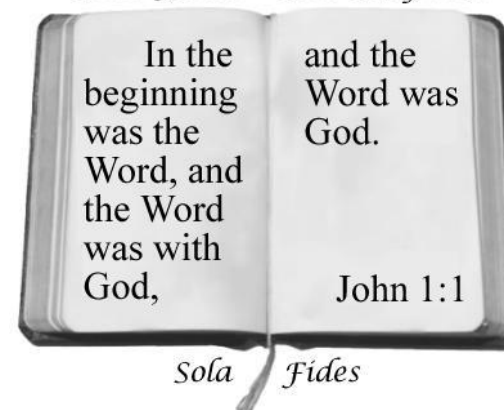
