1. Unescapable Disaster to the Wicked, v.1

- Judgment will be upon those who are proud and do wickedly (3:15).

 - A. Lamentation, Isaiah 13:6; Joel 1:15
 - B. Calamity & Terror, Is.13:7
 - C. Wrath, Isaiah 13:9, 13; Zeph.1:18, 2:2; 3:8
 - D. Devastation, Is.13:9
 - E. Cosmic changes of the sun & moon, Isaiah 13:10
 - F. Slaughter, Isaiah 34; Zeph.1:7,8

2. Unparalleled Deliverance to Believers, v.2,3

• Here are incredible promises for true believers described as those who "fear His name." (1:6; 1:11; 2:2,5)

A. A Dawning: The Sun of Righteousness shall arise:

2 Samuel 23:4; He shall be as the light of the morning, when the sun riseth, even a morning without clouds: as the tender grass springing out of the earth by clear shining after rain.

B. A Healing "with healing in His wings":

• HEALING! This speaks fo deliverance from all disease, disaster and death. Jeremiah 14:19; Jeremiah 15:18; Jer.17:14; Jer.30:17; Jer. 33:6.

C. A Renewing: "and ye shall go forth..."
