- III. The Final Hope (v23-28)
 - A. The 4 beasts are 4 kingdoms
 But the saints will possess THE Kingdom forever
 - B. The fourth terrifying beast and horn seem to triumph over the saints UNTIL (cf. Ezek 21:27) his power is simply taken away

- **Hope** in *your* darkest hour most glorifies Him Are you sure you are safely in His Kingdom?
- Confidence in obeying the Great Commission: He IS calling worshippers from every nation
