

The Sufficiency of Christ's Sacrifice

Christ's victory over Satan is largely noticeable in the manner in which Christ disarmed Satan. One of Satan's greatest weapons is the weapon of death. He uses the fear of death to enslave mankind to do that which man might not otherwise do. All of mankind is born into the world enslaved to the fear of death. The Devil has the power to use death as a weapon to keep people enslaved to fear all their lives. Many people can be persuaded to do things they would not normally do because of the fear of death. People will even do things they do not want to do because of the fear of death. The enslavement to the fear of death can also be seen in the manner that some lose their sense of joy in life and zest for life because of their fear of death.

For those who do not believe in a life with God after death and are not assured of enjoying the presence of God after death, the fear of death can be very enslaving. As long as man is enslaved to the fear of death, man cannot be living a life of fully trusting God in the manner that demonstrates Christ's solidarity with man. Christ's sacrifice has emancipated the believer from this horrendous enslavement.

Satan uses the reality of death to accomplish permanent separation between man and God.
