The Comforting Glory of the Enthroned Son of Man (2)

I. He is the Supreme Ruler over a secure Kingdom

II. He shall make worn out saints victorious over sin and evil

I. The comforting glory of Ascended Son of Man

- A. Daniel's received a symbolic pre-view of 4 successive kingdoms
- B. The Comfort in the heart of the vision (9-14)
 - 1. Vs. 9-10: throne was 'put in place' (so also Dutch) final judgment
 - 2. Vs. 11-12: judgment concerned the beast Satan & followers!
 - 3. vs. 13-14: a preview of Jesus' Ascension
 - a. Daniel did not use symbolic language
 - b. the Son of Man was Jesus' favorite self-description
 - c. He was brought **to** the Ancient of Days
 - d. He was given the authority over heaven and earth

II. He shall make worn out saints victorious over sin and evil

- A. Daniel's dream draws his attention to the 'saints'
 - 1. Who are and how do they become saints?
 - 2. Though now delivered saints, there is still ongoing battles
 - a. the *inside insurgents*
 - b. the foreign invaders

- B. How will the saints endure and win this battle?
 - 1. We will be more than conquerors ...
 - a. what is a conqueror?
 - b. what is a more than conqueror?
 - 2. Feed spiritually on the truths in Daniel 7 as captured well in Lord's Day 19
