I. Children in God's Family,

v1 - 3

v 1 lay aside - malice (6x) 1 Corinthians 5:8

guile (11x) Psalm 34:13

hypocrisy (6x) Isaiah 32:5

envies (1x) Proverbs 3:31, Acts 13:45, 1 Timothy 6:4

Verse 1 describes the corruptible seed of chapter 1 (v 23).

Verse 2 will examine the *new birth's* growth.

v 2 newborn babes - 1 Corinthians 3:1-2. Hebrews 5:13 & 13:9

The new babe must <u>desire</u> the <u>sincere milk of the word</u> = incorruptible seed (1:23).

desire - Psalm 63:1-2, Matthew 5:6

Only in English: sincere ~ sin + 'sear' = to burn, to scorch or cause to wither

As sin withers, the new babe grows. The key is having God's Bible = AV 1611.

The corruptible seeds (i.e. modern perversions) cannot remove the sin nor provide growth.

The proper growth sequence = 1 John 2:12-14

babe ... little children ... young men ... fathers

v 3 Psalm 34:8 & 119:57, Hebrews 6:5, 1 Timothy 4:6

II. Precious Stones in God's Temple, v 4 - 8

- v 4, 6-8 (1) Christ is the corner stone Daniel 2:34-35, 45

 disallowed of men Psalm 118:22, Acts 4:10-12, Ephesians 2:20

 chosen of God Luke 23:35
 - v 5 (2) We are lively stones ~ Deuteronomy 27:5-8, 1 Chronicles 29:2

III. Citizen's in the New Kingdom, v 9 - 10

The new birth allows us entry into the kingdom of God (John 3:3-7).

a chosen generation = Matthew 1:1 (we are no longer Genesis 5:1).

an holy nation = the Israel of God Galatians 6:16, Psalm 73:1, Exodus 19:5-6

chosen . . . peculiar Deuteronomy 7:6 & 26:18-19, Titus 2:14

out of darkness - Acts 26:18
