The Principle of Non-Retaliation

Christians are not to retaliate when insults are hurled at them, but we are allowed legal recourse when laws are broken.

Old Covenant Lex talionis: "eye for an eye," Exo. 21:23-25 vs New Covenant of Grace: Matt. 5:38-41

There are two important points not to miss here:

- 1) Something to Praise: God's sovereign appointments and His care over all.
- 2) Something to Practice: fervent seeking and yielded obedience to the will and the plan of God, love for all people, and a readiness to share Christ with anyone.
