THE MAIN POINT OF PSALM 110

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The Lord's chosen king,
who will also be the eternal priest,
will first be enthroned and then—
after a time—bring complete
justice to the world.

Three Survey Trips

1. Let's survey the Bible—from page 1 to Psalm 110.
2. Let's survey what Jesus and his apostles believed about Psalm 110.
3. Let's survey how the letter to the Hebrews explains Psalm 110.

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The world God created (aka, the world in which we live!) will one day be rescued from the curse of sin and death. It will happen through a man who will be both a descendant of Abraham as well as a descendant of David, and he will offer himself as a sacrifice and reign forever as king.

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- In Matthew 26:64, Jesus referred to himself as the King whom Psalm 110 described.
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- In Acts 7:55-56, the first Christian martyr, saw that Psalm 110 had become reality.

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- In Hebrews 10:12-13, the writer quotes Psalm 110:1-2.
- In Hebrews 12:2, the writer quotes Psalm 110:1.

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3. Since the ascended King is the church's head, pour your life into his church (Ephesians 1:20-22).
4. Since the ascended King will conquer every foe, don't fear death (1 Corinthians 15:24-26).
