#4. Trespass Offering (Leviticus 5:14-6:7)

- If the OC believer wanted to approach God: always brings a sacrifice
- To approach God, believer would bring a "burnt offering" (whole life)
- Food offering: an offering which contains the perfection which you don't have
- Purification offering or sin offering for unintentional sins
- Difference in sin offering and trespass offering: 1) public 2) private
- There are two cases of sin dealt with here in the "trespass offering"
 - 1. Fraud toward God in respect to things in his worship
 - 2. Fraud towards man
 - I. Defrauding the Lord: Make Full Restitution before Seeking Forgiveness by the Substitutionary Sacrifice (5:14-19)
- Trespass offering restitution was given when one defrauded God.

Num 5:5-7; Deut 32:51; Ecc 5:6; Matt 5:34-37; Lev 22:1-16

- 1. We defraud the Lord when we withhold or pervert the worship of God
- 2. We defraud the Lord if we live Christ dishonoring lives (James 4:1-10)
- 3. We defraud God when we fail to give him our *all*
- 4. We can trivialize the name of the Lord
- II. One who Defrauds another Must make Full restitution as Evidence of Repentance before Seeking Repentance through Sacrifice (6:1-7)
- Jesus said loving God & loving one's neighbor: together (Matt 22:37-40)
