Scripture: Colossians 3 Series: One Another #6

Singing: 449:1-2 – 175:1-4 – 298:1-3 – 48:3, 4, 7, 8

And above all these things, put on charity, which is the bond of perfectness. (Col. 3:14)

- A. Love is most distinguishing characteristics of Christianity (John 13:34-35)
 - 1. Charity is the crowning grace of all salvation virtues
 - 2. Charity is the bond into which all graces hinge
- B. Our love is always to be rooted and fed out of God's love in Christ (Ch. 1-3:4)

FIVE DIRECTIONS BY OUR CAPTAIN OF SALVATION ON "HOW TO SECURE AND STRENGTHEN THE BODY?"

I. LET PEACE OF GOD RULE OVER YOU AND OVER EACH OTHER

- A. Peace of God is blessed benefit of faith in Jesus Christ (John 1:12; Rom 5:1)
- B. This peace of God exists even though we are not perfectly obedient children!
 - 1. Though we 'fail Him daily' He remains in harmony with (Rom. 8:33-34)
 - 2. though we 'fail each other' we are to remain in harmony: vs. 15a a. definition of *rule* is 'act like a referee among players' (Eph. 4:3)
- C. Seek this by keeping our eyes on the Prince of Peace: Rom. 15:2-5

II. LET THANKFULNESS BE PRACTICED

- A. The expression of thankfulness is God's will (Eph. 5:20; 1 Thess. 5:18)
- B. Yet thankfulness for the peace of God always promotes harmony

III. LET THE WORD OF CHRIST BE YOUR DAILY DIET

- A. Word of Christ's teachings as given in His Walk and Talk
 - 1. Christ's teaching and interpretations of OT Scriptures were enriching
 - 2. Christ's teaching about the character of God were enriching
- B. What happens when such Words of X dwell richly in you? (Eph. 5:18)

IV. LET PROFITING EACH OTHER BE YOUR MAIN WARFARE

- A. Every true Christian is called to fight the Lord's battle (Eph. 6:10-11)
 - 1. The enemy to Christ's Kingdom is not only *outside the body*
- B. Each member of the body is to teach and admonish each other
 - 1. refer to positive teaching to profit others not to prove yourself (Eph. 4:29)
 - 2. the call to teach & admonish each other is the **4**th **office in NT Church** a. compare Rom. 15:14; 1 John 2:20
 - b. Puritans referred to this as the holy conferences

V. LET SINGING BE YOUR ATMOSPHERE

- A. Whatever the nature of the 'songs', they are to meet 3 requirements
 - 1. they are to teach/admonish others in Scriptural truth
 - 2. we are to sing them with grace in your heart
 - 3. we are to sing them to the LORD

People's spiritual quality is to be judged by their graces and not their gifts.

You are only as spiritual as you are Scriptural.
