Uncertainty & Responsibility

Ecclesiastes 11:1-6

- I. INVESTING FOR THE FUTURE (1-2)—think ahead and prepare
 - A. Cast Your Bread/Ship Your Grain (1)
 - 1. Financial Investment—invest in business, commerce/trade
 - 2. Benevolent Giving (Pr 11:25; 21:13; 22:9)—invest in people
 - a. People will help you when you need it.
 - **b.** <u>God</u> will reward you for your good deeds—either in this life or in the next.
 - 3. General Principle: invest for the future
 - a. Takes Forethought—quality of your life in the future
 - **b. Demands Patience**—wait a long time to receive the return
 - **d.** Requires <u>Risk</u>—out of your sight and out of your hands.
 - B. Give Portions to Seven (2)
 - 1. <u>Diversify</u> Financial Investment—manage your risk
 - **2. Generously Help Many People** (Lk 6:31, 36; 2 Cor 8:7; Php 4:18-19)
 - 3. **General Principle**: prepare for unexpected disaster
 - a. Calculate for contingencies. Plan for worst case scenario.
 - **b.** Invest in life. Assume that life will go on.
- II. <u>NATURAL CAUSES</u> (3-4)—physical forces affect what we are able to do
 - A. <u>If the Clouds are Full</u> (3a)
 - 1. You can't control the weather
 - 2. An example of generous giving

- B. Where the Tree Falls (3b)
 - 1. Laws of nature don't consider us.
 - 2. Be a blessing where you are.
- C. <u>Watching the Weather</u> (4)—Don't overthink it!
 - 1. Don't allow potential obstacles to stop you.
 - 2. Don't wait for perfect conditions.
 - 3. Risk is part of life.
- III. GOD'S MYSTERIOUS WAYS (5; Dt 29:29)—There are limits to our knowledge
 - A. The Path of the Wind (Jn 3:8)—where the wind will blow
 - **B.** The Formation of Life (Job 10:8-9; Ps 139:13-15;)—development of the human soul
 - **C.** <u>The Work of God</u> (Isa 46:9-10; 55:8-9; Rom 11:33-36)—His purpose and plans
- **IV.** WORKING WITH UNCERTAINTY (6; Dt 29:29; Pro 31:13-27; Gal 6:9; Php 2:13)—do different kinds of work
 - **A. Specific Advice**: Increase likelihood of success by doing more than one thing.
 - 1. Broaden your skills.
 - 2. Divide your efforts.
 - 3. Be <u>industrious</u>.
 - B. General Principles:
 - 1. There is work to do. Make yourself useful.
 - 2. Something will succeed. God has given you what you need to make it.
 - 3. **Do what you know to do** and don't **worry** about what you **don't** know.
