New Testament

2097. εὐαγγελίζω euaggelizo,
yoo-ang-ghel-id'-zo; from 2095 and 32;
to announce good news (“evangelize”)
especially the gospel:
— declare, bring (declare, show)
glad (good) tidings, preach (the gospel).

2098. εὐαγγέλιον euaggelion,
yoo-ang-ghel'-ee-on;
from the same as 2097;
a good message, i.e. the gospel.

2099. εὐαγγελιστής
euaggelistes,
yoo-ang-ghel-is-tace';
from 2097; a preacher of the
gospel: — evangelist.
