Context: Romans 16:25-27 concludes the letter to the Romans with a doxology that gives glory to God!

God is Wise!
Wisdom in Creation (Psalm 104:24; Jeremiah 10:11-12)
Wisdom in the Church (Ephesians 3:8-11)
Wisdom in the Gospel of Jesus (Isaiah 11:1-2; Matthew 13:53-54; Colossians 2:2-3; 1 Corinthians 1:18-25; 2:6-8)

How God showed his wisdom in the Gospel:

Take comfort (Romans 8:28-29; James 1:2-4)

Ask God for wisdom (Isaiah 33:5-6; James 1:5-8)
