## What Holiness Is Not

- It is not outward conformity to rules
- It is not moral conduct different from the world
- It is not religious duty to know commands
- Warfare daily between the Spirit and flesh for who rules the heart

## What Holiness Is

- A setting apart of life by God for God
- A willful dedication/consecration of all we are to all God is
- A progressive conformity to the character of the Holy Lord Jesus
- A daily warfare between the Spirit & flesh for who rules the heart
