## THE UNSEEN ARMY: HORSES AND CHARIOTS OF FIRE 2 Kings 6:8-23

- I. WHAT IS WHISPERED IN SECRET ()—God knows everything
  - **A. God Hears** (Ps 94:9-10)
    - **1.** The <u>Plans</u> of His Enemies (12; Isa 29:15)—God knew the plans of the king of Syria
    - 2. The Prayers of His Children (17, 18, 20; Ps 145:18-19; Jn 11:42; 1 Jn 5:14-15)—
  - **B. God Reveals** (Dan 2:47; Mat 10:26)
  - C. The Prophet Warns (Ezek 3:27 )—Elisha warns the king of Israel
- II. <u>BLINDNESS AND SIGHT</u> ()—physical eyesight, understanding or spiritual insight
  - A. Seeing the Light (Isa 9:2; 42:7)—when our spiritual eyes are opened
    - 1. Realizing Our Situation (Gen 3:7)—grace teaches our hearts to fear
    - 2. Recognizing the Glory of God (2 Cor 4:4)—converts, overcomes our fears
    - 3. <u>Understanding the Truth of the Gospel</u> (Lk 8:10)—a work of grace
  - **B.** <u>Encouraging the Fearful</u> (16-18; Job 42:5; Isa 35:3-6)—compassionate and best way to help them
    - 1. Speak to Them (Isa 35:3-6; Rom 8:31)—Remind them of the truth
    - 2. <u>Pray</u> for Them (Eph 1:18-19)—that God would open their eyes to see Him We can *tell* them, but we *can't make them see* it; only God can do that.
    - 3. <u>Lead</u> by Example ()—show us how it's done!
  - C. The Two-pronged Ministry of Christ (Jn 9:39)—not one-dimensional
    - 1. Giving Sight to the Blind (Isa 35:5; 42:18; Mat 11:25; Jn 9:32-33)—
    - 2. <u>Blinding Those Who Can See</u> (Isa 6:10; 29:9-10; Mk 4:11-12; Jn 12:37-42)--

## III. THOSE WHO ARE WITH US (16-17)—The Heavenly Host

- A. Do not be afraid. (Rom 8:31) If God is for us, who can stand against us?
- **B.** We are not alone. (Ps 16:8; Mat 28:20)
  - **1.** Invisible does not mean *imaginary*. (Col 1:16; Heb 11:1)—There is more to reality than we see.
  - 2. God's angels are real. (Heb 1:14; Ps 91:11-12)—serving and protecting
- **C.** The enemy's army is no match. (Ps 20:7; 68:17; 1 Jn 4:4)
- **IV.** TREATMENT OF ENEMIES (Ex 23:4-5; Mat 5:43-45)—the mercy and kindness of God
  - A. Respecting Their Humanity (Prov 25:21-22)—
    - 1. Basic Human Courtesy ()—treating fairly and decently under the circumstances
    - **2.** <u>Supernatural Christian Love</u> (Mat 5:44; Rom 5:10)—caring for their souls, desiring their good
  - B. Shaming Their Behavior (1 Pet 3:16; Rom 12:20-21)—burning coals
  - **C.** <u>Winning Their Hearts and Minds</u> (23; Ezek 18:23, 32)—bringing them into the kingdom of God
