# Prelude Call to Worship

We are called not only to sing praises to God but also to proclaim His deeds among "the peoples" (the nations of the whole world).

Sing praises to the LORD, who sits enthroned in Zion! Tell among the peoples his deeds!

#### We Acknowledge Our Sin

#### \* Reading from the Law

The imperative in this passage is implied, and perhaps hidden, were not the rest of God's revelation in subsequent redemptive history and the New Testament so clear. Simeon and Levi forfeited the preeminence among the tribes of Israel which would have passed from Reuben, the firstborn, to them (see verses 2 & 3) because of their cruel execution of the men of Shechem, and the failure that constituted to fulfill something that was a responsibility even at that stage of the covenant people: to be witnesses to and embodiments of the nature and character of the God of the covenant, the God of Israel, the one true God.

#### Genesis 49:5-12 ESV

- <sup>5</sup> "Simeon and Levi are brothers; weapons of violence are their swords.
- 6 Let my soul come not into their council;O my glory, be not joined to their company.

For in their anger they killed men, and in their willfulness they hamstrung oxen.

- <sup>7</sup> Cursed be their anger, for it is fierce, and their wrath, for it is cruel!
- I will divide them in Jacob and scatter them in Israel.
- 8 "Judah, your brothers shall praise you; your hand shall be on the neck of your enemies; your father's sons shall bow down before you.
- <sup>9</sup> Judah is a lion's cub;

from the prey, my son, you have gone up.

- He stooped down; he crouched as a lion and as a lioness; who dares rouse him?
- 10 The scepter shall not depart from Judah, nor the ruler's staff from between his feet, until tribute comes to him; and to him shall be the obedience of the peoples.
- Binding his foal to the vine and his donkey's colt to the choice vine, he has washed his garments in wine and his vesture in the blood of grapes.
- 12 His eyes are darker than wine, and his teeth whiter than milk. I Praise the LORD!

#### Silent Confession of Sin

#### Corporate Confession of Sin

This confession centers on the self-centeredness which results in failure to bear witness to Christ and the gospel to those who are in their sin and need to hear.

Compassionate and Gracious God, Who in the person of Your Son emptied yourself of all Your divine prerogatives for our sakes and gave to the uttermost, we humbly beseech your forgiveness for the narcissism and self-centeredness which we constantly display in the living of our lives: forgetting you, neglecting others and their needs, considering only our interests, needs, and desires. We have truly every one of us turned to our own way from time to time, wandering like lost sheep. But oh our Savior, we despise these our ways and appeal to Your infinite grace, that you would not only forgive these our sins, casting them into the depths of the sea and remembering them no more, but also that you would work in us that true obedience from the heart that both pleases you and blesses Your people, by the power of Your Spirit, in the name of Your precious Son Jesus Christ. Amen.

# WE REFOICE IN THE ASSURANCE OF FORGIVENESS

#### Assurance of Pardoning Grace

The healing of the nations and the blessings of eternity are mediated through the tree of life (ultimately Jesus Christ) and the River of Life (ultimately the Holy Spirit), both of which are mediated to the world through the Church (cf. John 4:10-15; 7:37-39; Haggai 2:1-9).

#### Revelation 22:1-4 ESV

Then the angel showed me the river of the water of life, bright as crystal, flowing from the throne of God and of the Lamb <sup>2</sup> through the middle of the street of the city; also, on either side of the river, the tree of life with its twelve kinds of fruit, yielding its

fruit each month. The leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations. <sup>3</sup> No longer will there be anything accursed, but the throne of God and of the Lamb will be in it, and his servants will worship him. <sup>4</sup> They will see his face, and his name will be on their foreheads.

Leader: This is the gospel. Congregation: Hallelujah!

#### Confession of Faith

#### The Apostles' Creed

#### Distribution of Elements

Because we believe that wine was used in the Last Supper and is thus more in accord with the fullness of symbolism intended by God in the Lord's Supper, we offer wine and encourage those who take part in Communion to take this. For those with conscientious convictions against the use of wine, however, we offer the option of grape juice, which is contained in the inner circle of the communion trays. The cups containing wine are in the outer circles of the trays.
