Jesus Rebukes

Matthew 26:55 At that time Jesus said to the crowds, "Have you come out with swords and clubs to arrest Me as you would against a robber? Every day I used to sit in the temple teaching and you did not seize Me.

John 18:19-24

I have spoken openly

to the world

always taught in synagogues

and in the temple

where all the Jews come together

I spoke nothing in secret

Why do you question me?

Question those who have heard what I spoke to them; they know what I said.

members of the Sanhedrin

Matthew 21:15, 23 When the chief priests and scribes saw the wonderful things that He had done.... When He entered the temple, the chief priests and the elders of the people came to Him while He was teaching...

officers standing nearby (v.22)

John 7:45-46 The officers then came to the chief priests and Pharisees, and they said to them, "Why did you not bring Him?" The officers answered, "Never has a man spoken the way this man speaks."

If I have spoken wrongly, testify of the wrong; but if rightly, why do you strike Me?

Why did Jesus rebuke?
