The Lamb with His Fair Army

Revelation 14:1-5

I. **Intro:** What would bring comfort to the heart of a battle-weary saint?
Samuel Rutherford

II. **Exposition:** A sneak preview of the glory to come (vv.1-5)

A. Seeing Christ in His glory and majesty (v.1a)

- Standing victorious on Mount Zion (Heb 12:22-24)

B. The redeemed saints with Christ in glory (v.1b; Rev 7)

1. A description of the redeemed (vv.1b, 4-5; Rev 7:13-14)

- Sealed and set apart for God's glory (v.1b; 7:3; John 6:39)
- Spiritually pure and morally blameless in His sight
(vv.4a,5; Heb 2:10)
- Redeemed from among men and consecrated
(v.4c; James 1:18)

2. Their/our blessed condition and activity (vv.2-3, 4b;
Rev 7:15-17)

- Singing praises to our glorious Redeemer (vv.2-3; 5:9-10)
- Continually in His presence (v.4b; 7:17)

III. **Application:**

1. Let the sight of His glory revive your weary soul
2. Let our theme song in heaven be our continual song here on earth
