MAIN TRUTH, CENTRAL SCRIPTURE, AND OUTLINE

Jesus Christ loves His people and even now is working on their behalf. He is the Great High Priest who ever lives to intercede for His people. Like a loving and faithful shepherd, Jesus cares for His people. Even now, He brings their petitions to the Father and is preparing a place a place for them to live under His eternal care.

- 1. The Lord's loving preparation for His own people (John 14:1-18)
 - A. He prepares the place Christ is always active. He is now in heaven working to serve and love His people. Out of sheer love, Jesus provides individually for each follower by promising a dwelling place for everyone in His glorious celestial city.
 - B. He prepares the people Only those who are saved can enter heaven, and only Jesus can do that saving work.
- 2. The Lord's loving prayer for His own people (John 17:1-9)

Christ prepares the church by answering believers' prayers and interceding for their needs.

- A.He answers prayers of believers
- B. He prays for believers Because Christ is the powerful Lord and Son of God, we can be certain that all of His prayers will be answered.
