QUESTIONS FOR GROWTH

- 3. If Paul is commanding us to let our 'gentle spirit' BE KNOWN TO ALL Ask yourself right now what about you is 'known to all'? In other words, what do people see in you when they are around you?
- 4. Can you think of a time you were treated unfairly or slandered? How did you respond? If you could turn time back, what would you change about that situation?
- 5. How can we guard our hearts or even train our hearts to not be irritated, intense, or legalistic over unimportant matters?
- 6. Which set of words describe you more when in a situation of being reviled or mistreated: {Impatient, intense, furious, inflexible, offended} OR {Gentleness, big-heartedness, forbearance, humble, gracious}?
- 7. Why do you think having a gentle spirit will cause us to stand firm?
- 8. How is our responding with gracious humility when we are sick or under trial or treated unjustly 'showing Christ off'?
- 9. What times in your life do you find it difficult to show others a spirit of gracious humility?
- 10. Why should the fact that 'the Lord is near' help us out when we find ourselves in difficult situations?
- 11. Have you turned from your sin in repentance and through faith depended on Christ alone for your righteousness and exchanged all that you are for all that He is?
- 12. This week meditate on Matthew 5:43-44; 1 Peter 2:20-23; 3:8-9; Romans 12:17 and think about how the Lord may be calling you to be different in the world.
