

- A. As central to the gospel as is the doctrine of Christ's death, is that of His resurrection.
- B. Indeed, the benefits of His resurrection which we enjoy, are possible only because He first died for sin, then arose as covenant Mediator.

Jehovah's Covenant Secret: The Resurrection of Our Covenant Mediator

I. The Historical Reality.

- A. That Jesus Christ arose in His body is a historical reality.

B. This historical reality of the resurrection is clearly taught in Scripture.

C. The church of Christ confesses this historical reality.

II. The Covenantal Significance.

- A. Christ's resurrection was significant as regards His own covenant fellowship with God.

B. Christ's resurrection is also significant for us, because Christ arose as the Mediator of the covenant.

III. The Saving Benefits.

- A. Our Catechism mentions three saving benefits for us of Christ's resurrection.

B. The child of God for whom Christ died can, must, and will experience these benefits.
