 - B. This is a striking petition, because it indicates that Agur looks to God for the supply of his basic, earthly needs.
- II. The Godly Motivation.
 - A. Agur's prayer indicates that his fundamental concern is not with his earthly life, but with his spiritual life.
 - B. The two related motives for his prayer are godly motives.
- III. The Confident Request.
 - A. The prayer breathes a confident trust in God.
 - B. With that confidence, let us bring our petitions to Him, at the beginning of this growing season.
