

Boldness With Each Other
Romans 15:15–16

There are certain expectations that we can have in church ministry.

- Churches being planted with Gentiles glorifying God - v. 9–12
- Divine joy and peace abounding in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit - v. 13

There is a confidence that we can have in church ministry.

- God has filled us with goodness and knowledge to have the wisdom to do right.
- We are able to rightly deal with any issue that may arise in the church.

There is a boldness that we can have in church ministry.

But I have written very boldly to you on some points so as to remind you again,

- Paul knew that the Christians in Rome had been taught the things he wrote about.
- Every church should be taught and grounded in the doctrinal truths found in Romans.
- Paul has spoken some straight forward and hard-hitting words in this epistle to the church at Rome:
- Personal Convictions - **Romans 14:3–4**; Government - **13:5**; Personal Relationships - **12:17–18**; Difficult and Controversial Doctrines - **9:11 & 11:25–26**; Sin - **6:12**;

because of the grace given to me by God, that I might be a minister of Jesus Christ to the Gentiles, ministering the gospel of God, that the offering of the Gentiles might be acceptable, sanctified by the Holy Spirit.

- Paul understood that he was saved by God's grace - **Ephesians 2:8–9 For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, not of works, lest anyone should boast.**
- Paul understood that God had given him his ministry as an apostle - **Romans 1:5–6**
- Paul understood that God had given him to be a priestly minister of Jesus Christ - **1 Peter 2:5 you also, as living stones, are being built up a spiritual house, a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.**
- God's grace has enabled every believer with a priestly ministry - **2 Corinthians 9:12; Heb 13:15 Therefore by Him let us continually offer the sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of our lips, giving thanks to His name.**
- Paul understood that his priestly ministry toward man was preaching the gospel.
- Paul understood that his priestly ministry toward God was the souls of Gentiles.
- Paul understood that his priestly ministry of offering souls was not only leading people to Christ for salvation but also leading believers to holiness.

Brother and sister, we have been given a priestly ministry, so we must speak boldly.

Romans 12:1 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service.

Romans 12:2 And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.
