#### SATAN THE ANGEL OF LIGHT

Previously, Satan was one of the leading angels—perhaps an archangel. He is called Lucifer and an angel of light. He would like to have been ruler of the world and he said five times in Isaiah 14:13-14, "I will." The final "I will" was: "I will be like the most High." He wanted to rule the world. He wants to rule all of his children.

#### THE LAMB OF GOD TAKING AWAY SIN

John the Baptist believed that the Lord Jesus Christ tasted death for every man, too. He did not say, "the sin of the elect." Instead of just a few, He said, "the sin of the world." He takes it away. As many have said, time and time again, it is no longer a sin question. He took away the sin of the world. It is the Son question. What have you done with the Lord Jesus Christ, God's Son? That is tasting death for every man.

#### CHRIST DIED FOR ALL THE UNGODLY
