Any and All in Christ - 2 Cor 5:17

- 1. As we relate to others, we demonstrate our "selves."
- 2. $\underline{2C5}$ THE definition of the self for the Xn $\underline{v14-17}$ loved by Jesus whose love is demonstrated in the cross & resurrection v15b
- 3. Therefore [result]: v16 new way of knowing; v17 we are made new

1st: Any and All in Christ = TITLE

- 1. *all* in v14-15 is bounded by the saving work of Christ: now live for Christ.
- **2.** v17 anyone w/o distinctions [according to the flesh -v16]. Col 3:9b-11. We are aware of differences but define in relation to Christ. 1C9:19-22; Rm 3:23
- **3.** Crucial distinction: *if he is in Christ.* 2 groups: in Christ or in Adam. Rm 5:12-19 contrast lives & legalities 2 "Federal [Cov] Heads"
- 4. How to view another Xn? Discern differences, but define in Christ.
- 5. v18ff trusted w/ message of reconciliation discern & define men

2nd: To Be in Christ

- 1. in Christ [73x] = defines "Xn" now & future. Indicative then imperative. Positioned then practice; made alive then live the life.
- 2. in Christ 2C5:14-15 united to Christ in His death & resurrection
- 3. Baptism Rm 6:1-13 ordinance = paradigm for Xn life: repent & faith

4. LT: Phil 3:8-11 union w/ Christ in His death & res = Paul's identity

Applic #1: How Do I View Myself?

- 1. If any man -> question: am I in Christ? 2C5:14-15.
- 2. Phil 3:12-14 retain & persevere. Live in communion w/ Jesus & His love.

Applic #2: How Do I View Other Believers?

- 1. Phil 3:15-16 you in v15 is plural. Differences among Xns do not remove our unified identity in Christ we are all taught of God [Jn 6:45].
- **2.** Jn 21:19-22 Peter on beach sees Jn: what about him? *You follow Me*.
- **3**. Forebear exemplify consistent growth as Father disciplines: follow Christ.

Applic #3: How Do I View Those Who Are Not in Christ?

- 1. Compassion. Deceived. Eph 2:12 in world, w/o God, w/o hope!
- **2.** <u>Tit 3:1-7</u> Cretans [1:12] see in rln to eternity: either cross or hell: mercy!

3. LT; resolve to live in union w/ Jesus: alive in Christ, then live in Christ.
